Winter 2026: "Embodied prayer" by the Rev. Liv Larson Andrews

Prayer is an important part of our relationship with God, and one of the ways we respond to God speaking in our lives. At the same time, we may carry all kinds of baggage or heavy questions about prayer: Am I doing it "right?" Do I pray enough? Is prayer always done with words? This two-part Bible study looks to Scripture as a guide to explore some different ways we can pray with our bodies—and with the body of the earth.

(January) Session One: Praying with our bodies Looking to the Apostle Paul, Mary, the Psalms and more, we'll learn about and try three embodied practices of prayer based on breathing techniques, the use of beads (such as the rosary) and praying in different postures (sitting, standing and kneeling).

A huge thank you to everyone who contributed offerings at our Thankoffering Service! The total collected was \$618.86. This will be sent to churchwide to help the many ministries that we as Women of the ELCA support.

There was a wonderful article in the September-November issue of Gather that was titled A legacy of generosity. It explained that "The spiritual practice of collecting Thankofferings began in the late 19th century.........Not long after came the idea of holding an annual Thankoffering service.......Today, Thankofferings sustain the ongoing ministries of the churchwide women's organization. Those ministries include justice and advocacy work, anti-racism training, scholarships, global education grants and a multitude of online and printed resources that raise awareness of issues like domestic violence, human trafficking and Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women, to name just a few".
