Purpose

Direct and develop the Celebrant Choir and choir ensembles.

Organizational Relationship

Reports to: Senior Pastor

General work hours - Average 6-8 hours per week for 40 weeks (mid-August to Mid-May).

Dress: Conform to a suitable dress code.

Reviews: Annual review will be completed by the Senior Pastor with input from the Personnel Committee.

Salary based on ELCA South Dakota Synod compensation guidelines.

Staff Expectations

1. Commitment to the mission of Jesus Christ and the Church.
2. Keep a strict confidentiality of pastoral ministry and office business.
3. Know that you represent the church and maintain an appropriate professional manner when relating to the public.
4. Ability to communicate and work with people of all ages.
5. Choose and mentor a volunteer assistant to become familiar with your responsibilities.
6. Membership at Grace Lutheran is encouraged. Membership in a Christian congregation is required.

Position Expectations

1. Understanding of Lutheran worship and liturgical practices, including familiarity with liturgy, seasonal emphasis, and sacramental understanding.
2. Experience in choral music and directing preferred
3. Ability to teach and encourage members and musicians with differing levels of talent and musical experience.

Specific Responsibilities

1. Direct the adult choir and choir ensembles (Singing Men/Singing Women or other subgroups that may be formed). This includes the organization and training of choir members and involves weekly choir rehearsals and music selection during the school year.
2. Actively recruit and invite new members to join the choir.
3. Schedule the choir to sing regularly at Sunday worship during the school year.
4. Prepare choir or ensembles to sing at special services such as Ash Wednesday, Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Reformation, and Christmas as scheduled in collaboration with the pastor and other musicians.
5. Provide information and content about choir and choir ensembles for church publications, social media, and digital communications.
6. Ensure that the music selected for the choir of Grace Lutheran is consistent with Lutheran theology and with the worship themes of the church year.

7. Attend planning meetings and/or collaborate with the pastor and the other musicians and adult and youth musical groups of the congregation in scheduling the choir and ensembles to sing in worship.
8. Work with the senior pastor and worship committee with planning for the choir music line items of the annual music ministry budget.
9. Communicate with appropriate staff as to upcoming music selections, rehearsal, and technology needs in a timely manner.
10. Find networking opportunities through staff meetings, retreats, continuing education opportunities, and local professional musicians' meetings.
11. Engage volunteers to assist with maintaining and caring for the music library and choir robes, and other task that arise.

This job description shall include but not be limited to the above duties. It is reasonable to expect that this job description may change slightly from time to time.
